PASTORS NOTES

EASTER ISN'T OVER

One of the things that we often don't realize is that in the church Easter is not one day but a season. It lasts for 50 days (even longer than Lent) and finds its climax on Pentecost when the Holy Spirit descends upon the Church. We even refer to the Sundays of this season in this way. For example, today is not the Third Sunday after Easter but the Third Sunday of Easter. One little word makes a difference in how we understand something. During this season, the Gospel stories tell us of the many ways in which Jesus reveals Himself as the risen Lord, the one who remains among us. The Gospel today reveals Jesus as being recognized in a simple meal of bread and fish shared with His Disciples on a beach. From a distance, he seems to be a stranger. Up close, at the table, in the intimacy of a meal He is recognized as the risen Lord.

In the Eucharist He comes to us in just that way. He comes as the risen Lord. Christ has died (past tense) but Christ is risen (present reality.) It is the risen Jesus, the Easter Jesus, who comes to us as He is now as we gather for the Eucharistic meal with Him. We need to get close enough to recognize Him.
