## Schedule

grades K - 5: Sunday morning, 9:00 -10:00 am  
grades 2 - 5: Monday afternoons, 4:45 - 6:00 pm  
grades 6 - 8: Tuesday evenings, 7:00 - 8:15 pm  
grades 9 - 11: Sunday evenings, 5:30 - 8:30 pm

The full schedule will be given out at our first class.

**Sacrament Prep:** students in Catholic Schools who plan to receive Reconciliation, 1st Eucharist or Confirmation this year must begin classes in September.

## WHERE DO WE GO??

**Sunday mornings:** grades K, 1, & 2 will meet in the hall where their catechists will call them and take them to their classes, all in the hall. Grades 3-5 will be in the Parish Office Center (POC - white house on the corner of Maple and McDonald Streets.) They DO NOT go to the hall the first week of classes. To get into the POC, enter from McDonald St. through the door marked "FF Sunday Classes". Classes are upstairs: there will be someone to direct them. All students will be brought down to the hall for dismissal. K-2 will be picked up in their classrooms. All other students will be asked to sit at tables by classroom until their parent *goes to* their catechist to get them.

**Monday afternoon & Tuesday evening classes:** meet in the hall each week. Grades 2-5 must be picked up inside the hall after classes. The evening students will meet their parents in the parking lot at dismissal.

**Sunday evening classes:** meet in the hall. Youth Ministry Nights will meet according to the schedule given on September 10th.

**CHILD PICK UP:** students in Sunday morning & Monday afternoon classes are to be picked up in the hall. They will not be allowed to go outside without an adult. All parents are encouraged to meet & get to know your child's Catechist! :)

**Faith Formation Manual:** We would ask that each family *read* through the manual, sign both the **emergency information** and the **compliance page** and return it to the catechist. Keep the manual handy at home as a reference through the year.

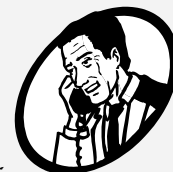
## **VOLUNTEERS NEEDED**
