## Pastor's Notes:

At 10:15 Mass, we will celebrate the Rite of Sending for our two RCIA candidates. At this Mass, they will be introduced to you by their sponsors and you will be asked to support them by prayer during these final weeks before Easter. This afternoon they will join all the other candidates and catechumens of the diocese for the Rite of Election where Bishop McManus will solemnly declare them to be Candidates for the sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation at the Easter Vigil. This same thing will happen in just about every Cathedral in the world today. It is a beautiful testimony that we truly are a Catholic (universal) church.

In today's bulletin, there is a pastoral letter from Bishop McManus addressed to all of us as we begin the holy season of Lent. This letter is one which the Bishop writes to us as chief pastor of the diocese and as chief teacher as well. In it he exhorts and encourages us to keep the season of Lent and to trust in God's merciful love which God has for us. Take the time to read it over and reflect on the words of our shepherd.
