Masses for our deceased loved ones:

There has been a sharp drop in Masses being requested for our loved ones who have passed away. Many people are opting not to have a funeral Mass for their loved ones. In fact, some of our older parishioners are worried that their children will not have a Mass for them when they die and have expressed their concern to me about it. I've told them to put it in writing. Many feel that since their parents weren't great church goers or that they themselves are not, that to have a Mass would be hypocritical. The opposite is true. In this parish everyone is welcome to be buried from the church. No one would be refused a Mass because they could not pay. The Mass has infinite value and is the way a Catholic should be honored. A Mass offered for a loved one unites them to the saving death and resurrection of Jesus and places them before God in a special way. Remembering them on the anniversary of their death is a fitting way to honor their memory. Masses can also be offered for the living as a spiritual gift on a birthday or to celebrate a special anniversary or to give thanks to God for an answered prayer. We need to bring God back into our lives. The Mass is a wonderful way to do so and may offer us comfort and grace ourselves. If you wish to book a Mass call the office and we will help you.
