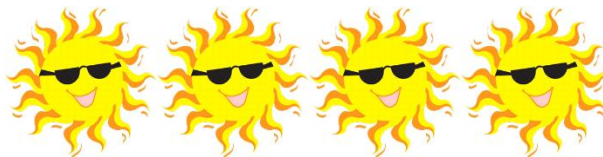
### PARTNERS IN CHARITY

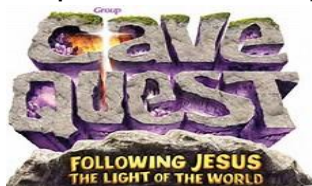
### NOVENA TO SAINT ANNE
