During the month of August, the Food Pantry will be open on Thursdays each week. We will not be open on Mondays during the summer. Check the schedule posted on the Pantry door for details.

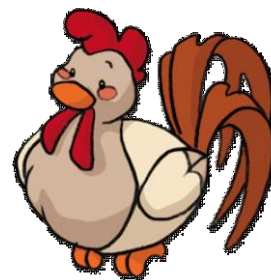
