Pastor's Notes:

Fifteen years ago four planes were hijacked and flown with malicious intent. Three of them hit targets in NYC and Washington, D.C. Courageously, passengers of the fourth plane fought the hijackers and brought the plane down in an unpopulated area. At the time American's and the world were stunned, and our world changed for our lifetime, and maybe forever. Fifteen years have passed by quickly, and I sometimes easily forget the intensity of September 11, 2001. This weekend, let us remember and pray for the people who died that day and their families, even the hijackers. Being Catholic Christians is not easy when we are asked to pray for people who hate us and wish us harm, but Christ and His Church call upon us to do so. Praying for and loving those who wish me harm is something that is not easy for me. But it challenges me and stretches me into the kind of person I believe I am called to be. At the same time, let us pray for all the innocent souls who perished that day and those affected by the loss.

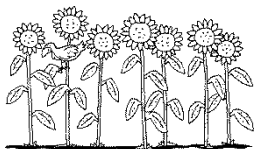
