March 5, 2017 8:30am - 4:00 pm

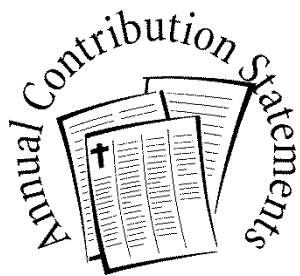
