A message from Fr. Bill

The Transfiguration of Christ is recorded in the first three Gospels, Mathew, Mark, and Luke. The fourth, John, does not recount the story, but John 1:14 could possibly be a reference to it: "We have seen his glory, the glory as of a father's only son, full of grace and truth." This voice from heaven was heard before, at his baptism in the Jordan. The words were "You are my Son, the Beloved." In each case a cloud overshadows him. In all three gospels this Transfiguration scene comes just after Jesus predicted his suffering and death for the first time. Death, and even the thought of death brings the whole of one's life into a fine point of focus. But that point is not a fading into extinction; it is a moment of Transfiguration. In this lies the meaning of our own suffering too. Through our Lenten practices and sacrifices, we die to excesses and unneeded pleasure, a sort of death that brings our spiritual life into focus so that we might be transformed into more loving and accepting people.
