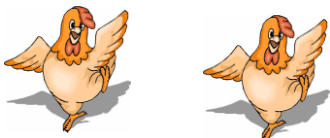

The Holy Trinity

Today we are celebrating the feast of the Holy Trinity. "Trinity" means "three" and tells us that there are three Persons in God. There is only one God, but God is a relationship of the Father and the Son, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit.

Each of the Persons in the Holy Trinity is really God, so the Father is really God, and Jesus is really God, and the Holy Spirit is really God. But they are not all the same Person. Each of the Persons in the Holy Trinity is also equal to all the others. So the Father is not greater than the Son or the Holy Spirit; they are all equal.

Sometimes we can understand the Holy Trinity as if it were like a family. The Holy Trinity is also a relationship of love, because God is so full of love He wanted to share it with others, and that is why He made us. When we live the way God wants us to, we are joining in the life of the Holy Trinity.

This weekend we came together as a community and "family" at our annual Bazaar. Hopefully our interaction has been a personally rewarding experience for each of us. Similar to the Holy Trinity, may our interactions imitate the love shared among the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, so that we may grow together spiritually.
